



## Winter Watering

In the fall, when it gets too cold to keep your irrigation system running, your new trees/plantings installed over the past few months will continue to need to be watered. We recommend watering thoroughly once or twice a week if conditions remain dry. When day time conditions cool down you can cut back to watering once every two weeks. If November, December or any of the winter months have low levels of snow, please water all trees once a month.

Please keep in mind that with the cold mornings that it is best to water after the ground has warmed up. Watering in the early mornings or too late in the evenings can cause the water to freeze and damage the plantings. Also, please keep in mind a long deep watering is much better for the plant material than more frequent shallow watering.

Please remember if conditions are dry in the spring, and it is too cold to activate the irrigation systems, all new plantings will again need water.
